Parents/Guardians Agreement

By registering as a member of Runaway Bay Little Athletics, I agree to the following terms on behalf of my family:

- ^ I understand that the Committee reserves the right to cancel our membership, if my child is found to be in attendance without a family member listed on the previous page or his/her behaviour is not of an acceptable standard.
- ^ I understand that depending on my child's age, Friday night competition will conclude anywhere between 7.30 and 9pm. An early finish time is only achieved with parental assistance eg: time keeping, place judging and helping run field events.
- ^ I understand that at least one of my child's parents or nominated guardians **MUST BE present AT ALL TIMES**. My child must not be left unattended, attend or arrive on Friday nights without a parent.
- ^ I understand that by registering with this Centre I have committed that at least one of my child's parents or guardians will actively assist with the running of competition **EVERY FRIDAY NIGHT** that the athlete competes.
- ^ I understand that **GUARDIANS MUST BE NAMED ON THE REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS AND CANNOT BE THE PARENTS OF ANOTHER ATTENDING ATHLETE**.
- ^ I understand that only athletes and adults actively helping as competition officials are allowed on the infield.
- ^ I understand that **EVERY ADULT CHIEFING, SPIKING, MEASURING OR RECORDING is required to complete the current jumps and throws questionnaire** as soon as possible, unless already a C or D grade accredited little athletics official. (I need to download the questionnaires from the RBLA website) In the interim I am permitted to help on an event if the event is being overseen by an official approved by the Committee. I realise **athletes are not permitted to undertake these roles or to retrieve during throws events**.
- ^ I understand that it is equally important for timekeepers and place judges to understand the rules. Therefore I understand that each parent/guardian is required to complete the track questionnaire as soon as possible, if we have assisted or intend assisting as a time keeper or place judge during the season. (I need to download questionnaires from the RBLA website)
- ^ I am aware that a parent levy is a component of the registration fee of the first child and that all members of my family are responsible for documenting our weekly assistance by filling out the parent levy sheet at either the field event, track venue or clubhouse where we have volunteered throughout the evening.
- ^ I understand that my family will only be offered a refund of this levy if the following criteria have been met:
 - A) That the athlete has competed on a minimum of ten (10) competition nights
 - B) That the athlete has competed after Christmas.
 - C) That sufficient written evidence exists to prove that the parents/guardians nominated on my registration documents have cumulatively assisted on 60-100% of the nights my child has competed.
- ^ I understand that the parent levy will be refunded on a sliding scale, depending exclusively on the percentage of nights written evidence. Therefore **eventhough a member of my family may help every night, our refund will reflect the number of nights my family have actually filled out the parent levy sheets**.
- ^ I understand that competition points towards age champion and other trophies will not be allocated until all fees have been paid in full and proof of age has been provided.
- ^ I understand that the wearing of our full uniform is compulsory and the uniform rules as documented in the Parents Handbook must be observed at all times.
- ^ I understand that athletes will receive **only one written warning** for a uniform infringement or walking around wearing spiked shoes. Thereafter **every repeat offence will result in competition points not being awarded for that competition night**.
- ^ To enable the Committee to identify and monitor the adults and children who attend each week with our registered athletes, upon arrival each Friday I am to ensure that the names of **EVERY PERSON** who attends with the athlete are printed next to the athletes name in the weekly attendance folder. I understand this includes non competing siblings, parents, grandparents and guests.
- ^ I understand that the Commission for Children & Young People requires all adults who volunteer, who are not the blood parent of the athlete to hold or apply for a blue card. This includes de facto's, step parents, grandparents, older siblings and guardians. I understand it is my responsibility to ask for a free application form when registering.
- ^ I understand that this Centre abides by the rules, policies and codes of conduct of Little Athletics Queensland which apply to all athletes, parents/guardians, coaches and officials. **Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated and will be dealt with accordingly by the Committee**.
